Bishop Richard Allen

Feb. 14, 1760 - Mar. 26, 1831

Bishop Richard Allen was born a slave and bought his freedom in 1783. He became a minister, educator, writer, and one of the United States' most active and influential black leaders of his time.



Bishop Allen founded a church in Philadelphia called "Bethel" in 1794 which would be the birthplace of the African Methodist Episcopal (AME), **the first independent Black denomination in the United States.**



Bishop Allen championed racial justice, literacy and community empowerment. Elected the first bishop of the AME Church in 1816, Allen focused on organizing a denomination in which free black people could worship without racial oppression and enslaved people could find a measure of dignity.

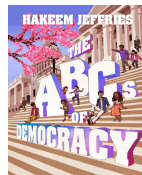

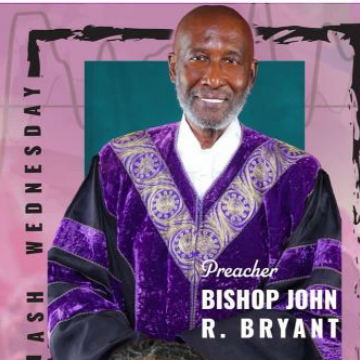
